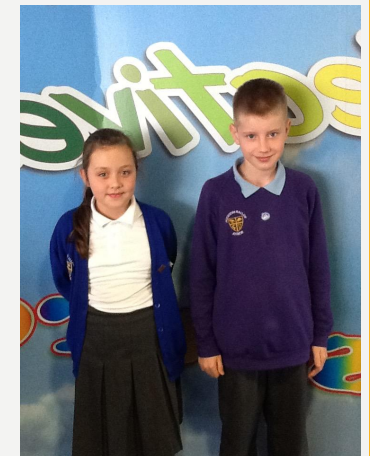

- Feed back to pupils about what happened about their views
- Make things happen – or explain why they can't!
