Keeping Children Safe at School

The following fact sheet is designed to help you understand the systems we have in place to help keep your children safe at School. Your support in following these systems is much appreciated.

Our school day starts at 8.50am and finishes at 3.30pm. Please promptly drop off your child at the start of the day and be punctual to collect them at the end.

If your child is ill please telephone 0151 355 1650 between 8.00am - 9.00am to report your child's first day of absence, and then every subsequent day your child will not be attending school.



If somebody different is going to pick up your child you should telephone school to give us the name of their person who will be picking them up, and their relationship to your child. The adult will then be asked for this information when they arrive to collect your child and your child will only be dismissed to them if the information matches.

Only adults aged 16 years and older should be bringing/collecting your child from school. We cannot dismiss your child to anyone under the age of 16.

All of the children in school are told that they should not talk to any adults passing by the school fences when they are working or playing outside.

Therefore, at lunchtimes when you are picking up or dropping off your child please could we ask that you do not talk to the children if they are playing on the field or playground. We understand that it may be your own child but this is difficult for the staff to manage so as a rule we say that none of the children should be talking to people passing by.

Please be aware that our front car park is used throughout the day by visitors to the school. It can therefore be very busy when your children are arriving and leaving school. The children are your responsibility at these times so please keep them close to you and ensure that they are well supervised in this car park. Please do not allow them to play near the edge of the pavements, run around the car park or climb.

We have four gates in to school, one on each corner and you should make use of these if the car park is full. May we remind you that the school climbing equipment is out of bounds before and after school. Please ensure that your child does not use it at this time.
