Learning focus

From Nursery to Year 6, our Computing lessons are thriving. Even our youngest, in Nursery and Reception, engage in roleplay with phones and cameras. Children in Reception explore touch technology and basic programs. Year 1 children are mastering computer skills, while Year 2 dive into algorithms. Years 3/4 explore computer mechanics with Google Slides
