### Learning Focus



This week we have had a specific focus on the geography skills of fieldwork and using maps, globes and atlases. In History, we have looked at how Key stage 1 has developed their use of the historical vocabulary and in Key Stage 2 we have had a focus on developing a secure chronological knowledge and use appropriate historical terms. We have been really impressed with the amount of coverage the children have been able to complete this year despite the challenges we have faced with the pandemic. It has been lovely to see the children that have managed to go on trips that have had a geographical focus on fieldwork. We have seen children using directional compasses and using these to make note of what they can see in each direction. This has resulted in children becoming more familiar with the compass points. Some children have even been able to consolidate their learning by using what they know to draw sketch maps.
