Therefore we have had to look very carefully at our outgoings and unfortunately the area of residential trips will have to be reduced.

You will receive further information soon in a letter to see how it affects your child, some changes will come in for the next year's budget and some trips are slightly different so the details will come to you a little later on - but I just wanted to make everyone aware. If you are feeling the strain of financial pressures this year don't forget there are people who you can talk to at either school, just give us a ring..... details on the websites. Despite this, we're determined to end the year on a high - so enjoy all your Christmas festivities with us where you can, your child is only this age once and it's so magical for them.
